Approved Minutes

1. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.
2. **Establish a Quorum:** Thirty-eight individuals were in attendance.
3. **Approval of Minutes of Annual Meeting:** After a motion, second, and voice vote, minutes of the General Meeting of April, 2021, were approved.
4. **Program**
 - A. Angela Roberts, of the Codes Compliance Office, made a presentation about the work her office does in enforcing various codes and code violations in the Downtown area.
 - B. Sarah Caper, Principal Planner for the Downtown Mobility Project, outlined the parameters and tentative findings her group has reached concerning current and potential mobility issues in the Downtown area, namely, how current vehicular traffic patterns trend and possible changes to street usage could affect those patterns. The tentative findings of the project will be released soon.
 - C. Gina Driscoll, City Council Member, spoke to the group, outlining various issues affecting our area, including the Red Tide, and listed various issues which, within the next few months, will be faced by the City and Council.
5. **Updates:** Karen updated the meeting about progress being made by the CALL program, assisting the Police Department; the proposal by the Vinoy to restore architectural details and use of space at the hotel. Mark noted that the dedication of the new sculpture at The Circle would be Thursday at 5:30 PM and invited all to attend.
