Tree planting program – the City has announced that every Neighborhood Association will be eligible to have 10 trees planted in a location of their choice. Diane Drutkowski will head the team to decide where the DNA would like our 10 trees. We agreed that we will solicit feedback from the DNA general membership with a recommendation that we stay within the limits of public parks and medians.

Dick Freeburg suggested that we write a letter to Don Shea of the Downtown Partnership proposing that the Looper Bus run from downtown to Tropicana Field on game nights. Dick Freeburg will draft a letter for Tim Baker's signature.
