Milt Meckler seconded the motion. The motion carried. Tim Baker and Peggy Spoor will send a letter to the Major and City Council members expressing our support. There will be a discussion at City Council on August 23 at 9 a.m. regarding WalMart building a new site on wetlands. The support of our citizens is needed.

Zoning Codes ? Tim Clemmons, DNA Board Member, has chaired a DNA Planning Committee to study the proposed new zoning rules for Downtown St. Petersburg. He updated the membership on the proposed zoning rules as well as the various definitions within those codes. The 3 areas of focus are; 1) district boundaries, 2) height limits, 3) overall size. Tim Clemmons requested authorization from the DNA to negotiate with the City using the DNA's Planning Committee recommendations as upper limits. A vote was taken and the motion carried.
