After The Storm Safety



Candles:

Use extreme caution when using candles. Pets and children can knock over candles. Battery operated flashlights and lanterns are safer.



Generators:

Operate generators in well ventilated locations OUTDOORS away from ALL doors, windows & vent openings.



TURN OFF Appliances:

If you have no power, please make sure you TURN OFF your appliances. Power can return unexpectedly and items placed on stovetops, for example, can catch fire.
